

FB2 – Frank Bridgeforth, “Coming Home – WWII”

Transcript: pp. 19-20

Time-Line: Decade V, Local and National Events, 1945, right after “September: Bridgeport Brass announces ... paragraph”

FB: I left the Navy in July of 1946...when I came home, it had seen like I hadn't been no place. Nothing had seemed to change. The same guys that were here when I left -- they were still there. They were, like, standing on the corner. The only thing different was they might have had different clothes on...That was about it. They were just standing around. They weren't working when I left, and when I came back, they still weren't working. And yet, there were quite a few jobs. I was going to school -- I was going to Bassick [high school] -- and I was working part-time in G.E.
